The City of Encinitas supports AB 1147, which would remove broad restrictions on local government's land use authority so that cities could more effectively zone and regulate massage establishments.

Kristin Gaspar Council Member AB 1147 allows local governments to enact ordinances that would require a certified massage establishment to obtain a license, permit or other authorization as long as that license, permit or other authorization is required of any other individual or business providing professional services. Having this land use authority returned will allow local governments to prevent businesses operating under the auspices of massage therapy from engaging in illicit activities.

For these reasons, the City of Encinitas supports AB 1147.
