## The New Norm: Cultural Changes in the #MeToo Era Workplace

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**SUMMARY OF SESSION:** California law requires basic workplace harassment prevention training for officials, managers and supervisors. - Developing relevant and appropriate media strategies for progressive messaging and crisis management
